The student is unable to finish the selection race due to factors beyond their control. The circumstances must be communicated to the Met North representative present at the trial, within 60 minutes of the end of the race. Completion of this does not imply automatic inclusion in the Met North Regional Team.</p> <p>3. As per Metropolitan North Policy, an athlete who is disqualified in the regional trial is ineligible for selection in the team unless there are vacancies due to insufficient numbers of eligible students. This event will be governed by the rules and regulations adopted by Triathlon Queensland.</p>
