NB: 13-19 Years Only boys with a handicap of 10 or less should nominate. Girls should have a recognised club handicap of 18 or less (Players with higher handicaps may be considered if insufficient nominations are received. These players will be contacted by the convenor if required).  NB: 10-12 Years All players should have a recognised club handicap. All players with a club handicap are encouraged to attend these trials. If insufficient starting times are available for the number of nominations received the highest handicap players will be balloted out and contacted by the Convenor should this be necessary.  Regional teams will not be selected ONLY on performance at this trial only. Handicap, previous experience and other recent performances will be considered.
