Eligibility	To be eligible to participate in this carnival, students must be 18 or under as at 31 December in the year of the State Championship and must turn 17 in the year of the State Championship. As a representative pathway with Qld Team selection, the Rugby Australia age dispensation policy and procedures will apply for 16 year old players (born 2008): australia.rugby/about/codes-and-policies/safety-and-welfare/player-dispensation Please be aware that the ARU has a mandated AGE GRADE DISPENSATION policy for all age level competitions in Australia. All players applying for the dispensation must complete Schedule A – WHICH MUST BE SIGNED BY AN ACCREDITED LEVEL 2 OR 3 COACH.		
	Additionally, 16-year-old players in the FRONT ROW (LOOSE HEAD PROP, HOOKER, TIGHT HEAD PROP) MUST ALSO complete Schedule B and submit to the ARU. This schedule B application must be approved by the ARU (this process may take more than two weeks). A copy of the approval letter MUST be submitted to the Convenor along with the Schedule A paperwork. 16-YEAR-OLD PLAYERS WITHOUT A COMPLETED AGE GRADE DISPENSATION FORM WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO TRIAL: Age Grade Dispensation Consent Form

	Nominations received outside of this process and/or after the prescribed due date above will not be accepted.

	District representative details must be submitted to the regional convenor on the appropriate form no later than 3pm on Friday 8 March 2024 .		
	Students who wish to be selected in the regional team must attend the regional selection trial.
