Payment and registration to attend trial	In 2022, there will be a moratorium on regional trial fees. Students will still need to register via the MN RSS Shop which will indicate a trial fee of \$25. Eligibility	Students born 2010, 2011 and 2012 are eligible to participate in this trial. SPECIAL NOTE: only players who have the ability and skill to participate at this level or higher should nominate.		
District team nomination to MNSS	The five (5) Districts comprising the Region are invited to send one (1) boy team and one (1) girl team to attend the trial. Maximum team size is 12 students (all participating in any one match) of players they consider of appropriate standard for this trial. Nominations for this event will only be accepted from Districts and must be submitted via the appropriate form. Please see your school’s HPE department if you wish to attend this regional selection trial. Nominations must be submitted by 3pm on Friday 25 March 2022 . Each District is responsible for sending ONE District representative to attend this selection trial to ensure Duty of Care is sufficient.		
Inability to trial	Students who wish to be selected in the regional team must attend the regional trial. If you are unable to attend the trial and wish to be considered for selection: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> MN Absentee application for exemption form must be completed Email must be sent to met.north@ged.qld.gov.au with supporting documentation attached e.g. medical certificate Completion of this form does not imply automatic inclusion in the regional team. Please note: students can only nominate to attend these trials through their relevant District.

Please remember: Attendance at this regional selection trial is dependent on registration via the [MN RSS Shop](#) and on the presentation of the Principal Approval/Student permission form to the District Official or Convenor.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The rules of Touch as set down by the A.T.A. will be followed unless stated otherwise below.

Squads are limited to a maximum of twelve (12) members with all twelve players participating in any one (1) match.

Each team to be accompanied by a Coach.

All games will be played for 20 minutes with no half time and no time off for injury.

Teams are to be dressed and ready to play at least ten (10) minutes before their match is due to start. All players require an identification number on the back of the playing top. Same number all day. No jewellery.

The “Tournament Committee” shall adjudicate on all matters of concern including protests. This Committee shall comprise:

- * Championship Convenor
- * Two other invited persons

All protests shall be lodged with the Tournament Committee in writing within ten (10) minutes of the termination of the game in question. This Committee will not accept protests regarding refereeing decisions.

If a player is sent off permanently from a game for any misdemeanour, the Tournament Committee will decide her/his penalty. There is no appeal over the decision of this Committee.

The format of play and carnival draw will be determined by the Convenor, once nominations have been received.
