Eligibility	<p>The age groups for 15 years State Championships is strictly 15 years and under as 31 December in the year of competition, and for 18 years State Championships, 18 years and under as at 31 December in the year of competition.</p> <p>SPECIAL NOTE: only players who have the ability and skill to participate at this level or higher should nominate.</p>		

<p>District team nomination to MNSS</p>	<p>The five (5) Districts comprising the Region are invited to send one (1) male and one (1) female team in each age division to attend these trials. Maximum team size is 14 players they consider of appropriate standard for this trial.</p> <p>Nominations for this event will only be accepted from Districts and must be submitted via the appropriate form. Please see your school's HPE department if you wish to attend this regional selection trial.</p> <p>Nominations must be submitted by 3pm on Friday 11 March 2022.</p> <p>Districts are also invited to provide one suitably qualified referee per team. Student officials/referees can be selected in the Met North team to attend the State Championship. Please ensure referees name and school is included on the team list/nomination form.</p> <p>Each District is responsible for sending ONE District representative to attend this selection trial to ensure Duty of Care is sufficient.</p>
<p>Inability to trial</p>	<p>Students who wish to be selected in the regional team must attend the regional trial. If you are unable to attend the trial and wish to be considered for selection:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. MN Absentee application for exemption form must be completed 2. Email must be sent to met.north@ged.qld.gov.au with supporting documentation attached e.g. medical certificate <p>Completion of this form does not imply automatic inclusion in the regional team.</p> <p>Please note: students can only nominate to attend these trials through their relevant District. Nominations outside of this process will not be accepted.</p>

<p>MN team selection</p>	<p>One (1) male and one (1) female team will be selected in each age group to contest the State Championship. Teams will be a maximum of 14 members, as per QSS policy.</p>
