Eligibility	To be eligible to participate in this carnival, students must be 15 or under as at 31 December in the year of the State Championship and must turn 13 in the year of the State Championship.

District team nomination to MNSS	<p>The five (5) Districts comprising the Region are invited to send one (1) team to attend the trial. Maximum team size is twenty-three (23) players they consider of appropriate standard for this trial.</p> <p>Student nominations for this event will only be accepted from Districts and must be sent via the appropriate form. Please see your school’s HPE department if you wish to attend this regional selection trial. Nominations must be submitted by 3pm on Tuesday 5 March 2024.</p> <p>SPECIAL NOTE: only students who have the ability and skill to participate at this level or higher should nominate. Any student deemed unsuitable or dangerous for them to participate will be immediately removed from the trial process.</p> <p>Nominations received outside of this process and/or after the prescribed due date above will not be accepted.</p>		
District team representative	<p>Each District is responsible for sending ONE District representative to attend this selection trial to ensure Duty of Care is sufficient.</p> <p>District representative details must be submitted to the regional convenor on the appropriate form no later than 3pm on Tuesday 5 March 2024.</p>		
Absentee Application for Exemption	Students who wish to be selected in the regional team must attend the regional selection trial.
