Students will wear appropriate playing apparel, e.g. playing shorts, playing shirts, shin pads (compulsory), mouthguard (optional), long socks (compulsory), footwear (i.e. soccer boots/grass sport shoes).

Goalkeepers will wear a shirt that identifies them as the goalkeeper for that team. Please check that your keeper's shirt does not clash in colour with your team and the opponent's team colours.

Students are to be reminded that all jewellery has to be removed before playing. Taping is not an option.

## COMPETITION RULES

- Games are 20 minutes each way - 5 minute break
- SUBSTITUTIONS - unlimited interchange

Interchanges are to be made during a stoppage of play e.g. throw in, free kick. Player to be changed may go off the field first at the nearest touch (side) line. Player going on must enter at the halfway line from the interchange area.

- Cautions (yellow card) and send offs (red card)

Two yellow cards in a game, player sent off - no substitution allowed
Red card, player sent off immediately - no substitutions allowed
For a send-off a *half match or one match suspension will apply.
For players who receive three or more yellow cards over the course of the carnival, a match suspension will apply.

- POINTS WIN 4 DRAW 2 LOSS 1

In the event of two or more teams having equal points at the end of the round robin, the method for determining the winning team will be as follows.
A. If two teams are tied at the end of the carnival, the result of the game between the teams in the round robin will determine the placing. E.g. If Team $A$ and Team $B$ have equal points at the end of the round robin but Team A beat Team B in their fixture the championship will go to Team A.
B. In the event of the tied teams having a draw in their round robin fixture, goal difference will determine the winner. E.g. If Team A has a greater goal difference then Team B it will be declared the championship team.
C. In the event of the equal goal difference then the team that has scored most goals will be declared the championship team
D. In the event of three or more teams having equal points at the end of the round robin the winning of the championship will be determined on goal difference (Part B and C).

## PENALTIES FOR SEND OFFS

It is unusual for this to occur but:
As there are not many games, the suspension punishment will be based on 'fitting' the crime. A minimum half game suspension may occur for some offences.
Deliberate FOUL PLAY and ABUSIVE language will be a one (or more) match suspension.
CLEAN UP - At the end of a game teams tidy up the area they used before vacating the grounds.
