<b>Eligibility</b>	<p><b>To compete in the 10-11 years competition</b>, students must be 11 or under as at 31 December in the year of the State Championship and must turn 10 in the year of the State Championship.</p> <p><b>To compete in the 11-12 years competition</b>, students must be 12 or under as at 31 December in the year of the State Championship and must turn 11 in the year of the State Championship.</p>
